

North Surrey Skating Club 2023-2024 Volunteer Program

Skate Canada is a very successful national organization and one of the reasons for this is the involvement of thousands of volunteers that help to keep things running. Volunteers have been volunteering for over 50 years. There are many types of volunteer positions available and these can range from playing music at a skating club to making policy at the national board level. Each year Skate Canada pays tribute to its volunteers at its annual meeting and awards to those who contributions have been recognized by their peers.

Volunteering at North Surrey Skating Club (NSSC)

As a non-profit organization, North Surrey Skating club (NSSC) is run and managed by a group of volunteers: the NSSC Board and Skaters' parents. Volunteer work is essential to the quality and success of our Club, and to your child's experience here. Prior experience is not required. Volunteering in the Club is a great opportunity to learn about the sport of figure skating and how the Club runs, as well as a fun way to meet other Club members and have a good time while helping out.

Skaters registered in Rising or Adult or Open, must Volunteer for a minimum of 2 hours per season. These groups will receive no perks, and have the option to opt out of Volunteer and pay an amount of \$150. Junior, or Intermediate, or Senior or Diamond levels are required to fulfill the required number of hours .You will receive perks, and have the option to opt out of Volunteer and pay an amount of \$150. Junior, Intermediate, or Senior/ Diamond Skaters who Opt In for Volunteer must submit Volunteer Form and a post dated April 1, 2024 cheque of \$300 when registering at any time during the Fall, Winter, and Spring sessions in the current skating year (September 2023 to June 2024). Perks are for Skaters who have been with Nssc for at least 1 year period. If you are new to Nssc and Opt In to Volunteer, you will receive 10% discount off Ice for early registration Only. (No discount on Group Program or Off- ice or edge sessions). Volunteer perks are for Skaters who skate exclusively with and on Nssc Ice Only. Skater is subject to be review for qualification.

On the volunteer form, NSSC members are to indicate their choice of two options:

1. Volunteer Deposit:

Those who choose the Volunteer deposit option must submit a **Volunteer form and <u>postdated</u> cheque for \$300**. The specified hours of volunteering for the Club must be completed and documented by **June 15, 2024** otherwise the Volunteer Deposit postdated cheque will be cashed.

2. Volunteer Fee:

Those who choose the <u>Volunteer Fee/Opt out</u> option must submit a <u>Volunteer form and an immediately dated</u> cheque payment for the amount of \$150. This cheque will be cashed immediately and the family is not required to perform a minimum number of volunteer hours. You will have the option to add this subscription to your registration and pay online. You will be



charged if no Volunteer Activities have been made on your account. It is your responsibility to contact the Volunteer chair to avoid being Charged the Volunteer Opt out Fee \$150.

Please note: There is no partial option for hours or payment amount; the two choices are fulfilling the specified number of hours of volunteering <u>OR</u> making the payment of \$150.

^{*}Note Requirement of a minimum of 2 hours per season (ie. 4 hours or more Fall+ Winter, and 2 hours or more for Spring, etc.)

The number of hours is per immediate family, not per skater, and is based on the highest skater designation in the family. Those who choose the Volunteer Deposit option must complete the specified minimum number of hours based on their skater's designation.

The volunteer hours requirement will be prorated for midyear promotions (partial or full), or from Rising Stars to Junior Group Category: and for those registering in programs after September 2023 Please be sure to contact Volunteer Coordinator at volunteerwithnssc@gmail.com

<u>Important:</u> The maximum number of completed volunteer hours accrued for the Fall/Winter season will be capped at 70%. The remaining 30% will have to be completed during the Spring Season.

For Example: A Junior Group skater is required to Complete 10 hours of volunteer time. 70% of hours (7 hours) is the maximum number of volunteer hours allowed to accrue during the Fall/Winter season, and the remaining 30% of 10hours (3 hours) should be completed in the Spring. This restriction ensures that we have enough volunteers to operate club functions during the Spring Season.

Volunteer hours cannot be carried over into the subsequent year(s).

Board Members will get full credits for their volunteer hours.

Volunteers Opportunities

Notification will be sent out by e-mail (via Sign Up Genius) Tasks are assigned on a first come first serve basis and managed by the volunteer coordinator.

It is the responsibility of parents to ensure they provide a valid e-mail address and fulfill the minimum hours' requirement if they would like their deposit cheque returned. Completed task/hours will be recorded on an ongoing basis in a volunteer Hours Log by our volunteer chair, please make sure you refer to your most up to date volunteer sign ups log.



Tasks are assigned and managed by the club's Volunteer Coordinator, and not by the coaching team. If a coach suggests a job please discuss it with the Volunteer Coordinator before taking on the task if you want to receive credit for the time.

Volunteer Benefits *** Applies to Nssc members who skate exclusively on Nssc Ice Only. Skater is subject to be review for qualification.
